Colston Girls School, Cheltenham Road – 09/05104/VP-13.12.2009. Pollard 8 hybrid Black Poplar trees as outlined in submitted arboricultural report. Trees protected by Tress Preservation order 124. No comment required.

Colston Girls School, Cheltenham Road – 09/05130/VC – 13.12.2009. Fell one Silver Birch (T0151), one Holly (T0152), one Cherry (T0150) and one Walnut (T0149). No comment required.

Land to the rear of 9 Sussex Place, Ashfield Place – 09/04687/F – 20.12.2009. Conversion and extension of existing garage to form a single dwelling house. Letter to object to: uncertainty about materials, uPVC is unacceptable for windows, roof tiles should be clay not concrete, uneasy relationship between dormers, roof slope and main façade needs to be resolved.

Colston Girls School, Cheltenham Road – 10/00013/LC and 10/00012/FB – 3.01.2010. Proposed demolition of existing buildings, including the changing rooms, caretaker's flat and other associated structures. The erection of a three storey arts block on Cheltenham Road and the associated felling and replacement of an existing London Plane on the pavement. Construction of a single storey music block within a bank adjacent to the tennis courts. External alterations to existing buildings. Use of part of the ground floor of Nos 180A and 180B Cheltenham Road for educational purposes. Creation of a car park off Station Road. Associated landscaping works within the school. Letter to accept reduction of height and music block, but to object that mitigation is grossly inadequate, that plane tree should be maintained, that signage still not shown.
